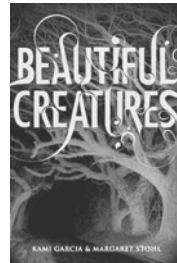
**IF I STAY**

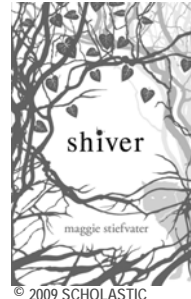
